The consumer can be enrolled by mail, phone, or web. Existing consumers have transferred over to them. In the past there was a one-time annual registration fee. For those consumers, there is no additional charge unless the "Personal Health Record system" is activated i.e. they're called to activate the system as the person has wandered. If this happens, they would then need to have the \$25 annual renewal fee as part of their service costs.

For new consumers, there would be 2 costs that you would need to enter. One would be the initial registration (\$54.90) and then you would need to set up the annual renewal fee which would be \$25 and would occur 12 months after enrollment. This is an enhancement piece and is still covered under the definition of Wanderer Locator Service.
