**Councils on Aging**– Some councils on aging maintain a list of people and companies that provide yard and garden services or snow removal. Some COA's have information about volunteer programs. **Gloucester/Rockport Handyman Program:** A local retired carpenter is available for senior residents of Gloucester and Rockport. Services include all small carpentry jobs, inside or outside your home.
