Rosemary F. Kerry Community Service Award

Sefatia Romeo Theken Mayor, City of Gloucester



Gloucester is America's oldest seaport. Known throughout the world as an authentic, working waterfront community, Gloucester is a place of spectacular natural beauty, and home to a diverse population of about 30,000 residents. An important center for the fishing industry, Gloucester also is proud of its vibrant cultural life and rich art heritage as one of the premier art colonies in the United States. In addition, the city is a destination for thousands of visitors who visit the harbor and its beaches during the summertime.

On November 3, 2015, Sefatia Romeo Theken was elected to a two-year term as Mayor of Gloucester with 56% of the vote. She had served as Mayor since January 8, 2015, when she was unanimously elected by her colleagues on the Gloucester City Council to serve as Mayor until December 31, 2015. An At Large City Councilor since 2001, Sefatia was elected Vice President of the Gloucester City Council on January 1, 2008, an office she held until she became Mayor.

Throughout Mayor Romeo Theken's professional career, she has been a leader in the struggle for health care access for individuals and companies. Prior to her election as

Mayor, she had been the Community Health & Human Services Liaison at Addison Gilbert Hospital since 1997. Mayor Romeo Theken is a dynamic and tireless leader within the Gloucester community who always puts the interests of the residents of Gloucester first. She is a staunch advocate for small businesses, having owned a fishing vessel, operated her own catering business, as well as a healthcare consulting business.

When an economic downturn hit the fishing industry in the early 1990's, Mayor Romeo Theken moved quickly to push for a program to address the health care needs of fishing families. In collaboration with the Gloucester Fishermen's Wives Association, she lobbied for and helped implement the Massachusetts Fishermen's Partnership which provided health insurance coverage for fishermen and their families throughout Massachusetts. Mayor Romeo Theken is an outspoken advocate for the fishermen and shore-side businesses who continue to struggle as a result of unprecedented cuts in allowable catches and the over regulation of the fishing industry.

Mayor Romeo Theken is a certified Executive Office of Elder Affairs SHINE (Serving the Health Insurance Needs to Everyone) Counselor and a Certified Medicaid Counselor/CAC. She has been awarded the North Shore Health Project Community Health Activist Award (2014); the Red Cross Community Hero Award (2011); the Outstanding Outreach Educator Award from the Community Health Education Center and the MA Department of Public Health; the People Against the Tide Community Leadership Award from Health Care for All Massachusetts; an award from Figlia di Trappeto; an award from the Italian Consulate; and the Women Honoring Women award from Wellspring.

A lifelong resident of Gloucester, Mayor Romeo Theken is married to Matthew F. Theken. She is the mother of three grown daughters and grandmother of four.

is presented annually to an individual of outstanding character, who gives of their time, expertise, or resources, showing the highest level of community service to improve the quality of life of elders.

Diane T. Stringer President and Chief Executive Officer, Care Dimensions



Diane Stringer has been President and Chief Executive Officer of Care Dimensions (formerly Hospice of the North Shore & Greater Boston) since 1989, transforming the organization from a small volunteer program to its present position as the largest hospice in New England. Serving more than 5,000 patients per year in 90 eastern Massachusetts communities, the organization employs 490 paid staff and has more than 400 volunteers.

Under Diane's leadership, Care Dimensions developed Massachusetts' first licensed hospice inpatient facility, the 20-bed Kaplan Family Hospice House, as well as collaborated with area health systems to establish inpatient hospice units in Salem and Gloucester. Other innovative programs include Palliative Care of the North Shore & Greater Boston, and the Bertolon Center for Grief and Healing, which offers bereavement support and counseling to anyone in the community who has suffered a loss. In addition, the organization developed a pediatric palliative care and hospice program to support children with life-limiting illnesses, and their families. In 2011, Care Dimensions acquired Partners Hospice, and became the preferred hospice provider of the Partners Healthcare System.

Diane has held various leadership positions with the Hospice and Palliative Care Federation of Massachusetts, including a term as President. She led efforts to expand access to hospice care in the Commonwealth by securing passage of legislation to mandate hospice as a covered benefit by all insurers, and to license freestanding hospice inpatient facilities. She has also served on several committees for the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization, and as a member of organization's board of directors from 2003 to 2008. In 2010, she was appointed by Governor Deval Patrick to serve on Massachusetts' Expert Panel on End-of-Life Care.

Diane's leadership in community, educational and not-for-profit organizations has included service on the Boards of Directors of Salem State University (2012 – current), the North Shore Chamber of Commerce (2005 – current) and Danversbank (1999 – 2011). She has also served as a member of the North Shore Medical Center Quality and Medical Affairs Committee, Northeast Health Systems Governance Committee, and the Hamilton-Wenham School Health Advisory Committee.

Diane earned a Master's degree in Health Policy and Management from Harvard University School of Public Health in 1982, and a Bachelor's degree in Nursing from Case Western Reserve University (1976). Prior to joining Hospice of the North Shore & Greater Boston, she held increasingly responsible positions in nursing and hospital administration in Boston.

A resident of Gloucester, Diane enjoys travel, cooking and bicycling in her free time. She has two adult children.

Board of Directors Community Partners Special Recognition Award

Andrew DeFranza Executive Director, Harborlight Community Partners



Andrew DeFranza has served as the Executive Director of Harborlight Community Partners (HCP) since 2007, and has been in leadership roles in the non-profit sector for the last 17 years in New England and the upper Mid-west. Andrew describes himself as a "short, working class, Italian guy from New Jersey with an accidental white collar education"; he is passionately dedicated to creating housing for all while also challenging the systems and issues which create hurdles to such. His work with HCP is to develop and manage housing for people with limited incomes: parents, grandparents, working families, people with disabilities. HCP's housing portfolio encompasses 420 units, providing homes for over 600 people; 370 units are on the North Shore, with the remainder under management through an affiliation with the Women's Institute for Housing and Economic Development (WIHED).

HCP is an amalgamation of several smaller nonprofits. Over the past eight years, under Andrew's leadership, HCP coordinated partnerships between ten non-profits, ranging from merger to acquisition and contractual agreements. This resulted in a sharpened, missional focus and organizational infrastructure capable of creating and managing regional affordable housing. Concurrently throughout these eight years, HCP continued

to create integrated housing and service models for fixed income seniors and improve its family housing. With a unique approach to caring for those in need of housing, HCP regards every resident as a neighbor and is treated as such with dignity and respect.

Prior to leading HCP, Andrew was the Executive Director of a homelessness organization in Milwaukee (Guest House). He holds an M.A. in Theology (Social Ethics) and an M.S. in Community Economic Development. He has a particular interest in creative local financing and sustainable systems and business structures for non-profits.

While leading Harborlight Community Partners, Andrew and the HCP staff have been driven by a commitment to ensure that services and systems are in place to ensure HCP's senior residents can age in place, with peace of mind and dignity. SeniorCare has been an outstanding collaborator toward this goal. Over the past several years, Andrew has come to know and appreciate the dedication and work of SeniorCare and its staff, and is humbled to receive this award from such a respected partner agency.






